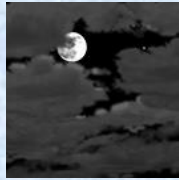
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure will track across Anvers Island, bringing high wind speeds and snowfall. Snow will taper off throughout the day, but high wind speeds will linger for all of Monday. On Tuesday, a high will move over Palmer Station and winds will decrease along with the cloud coverage.
