**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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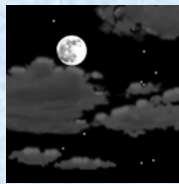
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A weak low pressure system is currently tracking across the Antarctic Peninsula. High pressure and ridging will build behind the low as it moves downstream. Winds will remain light until Friday night where they will increase slightly along with snowfall due to another weak low pressure system moving through the Bellingshausen Sea.
