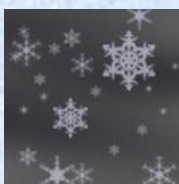
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure will remain over the Antarctic Peninsula with lows moving throughout the area for the next two days. Winds will be light with the weak pressure gradient on Monday and snow will continue to fall. A low pressure system will form over the Antarctic Peninsula on Tuesday evening and cause winds to increase and heavier snowfall.
