**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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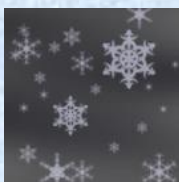
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure will form on the southern portion of the Antarctic Peninsula, bringing snowfall for all of Tuesday. The low will move out to the east and stall in the Weddell Sea causing clouds to move out but also a tightened pressure gradient. Winds will increase greatly on Wednesday morning that will persist for the remainder of the day.
