**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

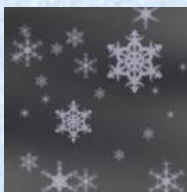

A low pressure center located over the Bellingshausen Sea in the saddle of the Antarctic Peninsula is producing extensive cloud cover, periods of mixed precipitation and gusty winds for Anvers Island.

**Sky:** Mostly cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasionally 1-3 in mixed rain and snow

**Wind (kts):** N 20-25 gusting 35, becoming NE 10-15 gusting 20 by evening

**Min Wind Chill:** -5°C / 23°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 1-3 in mixed rain and snow, becoming unrestricted by early morning

**Wind (kts):** NE 5-10

**Min Temp:** -2°C / 28°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM)** Unrestricted, becoming 1-3 in snow by evening

**Wind (kts):** NNE 10-15

**Max Temp:** 3°C / 37°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -11°C / 12°F
