PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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This morning through the early afternoon, expect a reprieve from poor weather as Anvers Island sits in a slightly calm area between two migratory low pressure systems. By the afternoon, another low pressure system is expected to impact the region, bringing gusty winds, blowing snow, and some additional snowfall. Conditions are still expected to be gusty tomorrow as the low passes over the Antarctic Peninsula.
