PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

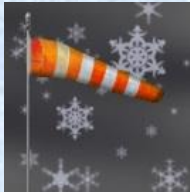
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Today and tonight Anvers Island will still be under the influence of a large dynamic low that is transitioning across the Antarctic Peninsula providing increased winds, a wintry mix of precipitation and low visibility. Fortunately this system is replaced by relative high pressure across the area tomorrow afternoon which will clear up the cloud cover making for a pretty nice day out with less cloud cover, light winds and no precipitation.

Visibility (SM): 1-3 due to snow and blowing snow

Visibility (SM): 2-4 due to snow and blowing snow in the am becoming 7 in the afternoon
