PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

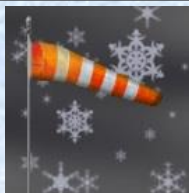

Tonight, look for winds to swing to the north and increase after dinner due to a decaying low pressure center running up against Anvers Island. Tomorrow, the sun ought to make an appearance and winds will become more tolerable in the afternoon. A more developed low pressure system may be on the horizon for Wednesday.

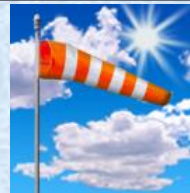

Visibility (SM): 4-6 with light snow towards morning

Wind (kts): Becoming N 20-25

Min Temp: -7°C / 19°F

Min Wind Chill: -17°C / 1°F

Visibility (SM): 2-4 with light snow early, becoming unrestricted

Wind (kts): ESE 25 gusting 30, becoming N at 10
