Another somewhat disorganized low pressure system will cross across the Antarctic Peninsula this period bringing stronger winds and another shot of snow and reduced visibility. By tomorrow any chance of precipitation is minimal but cloud cover will remain over the station the duration of the day.

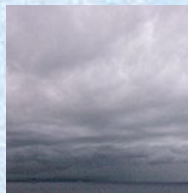

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted with occasional 4-6 with light snow

Wind (kts): NE 10-15

Max Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Visibility (SM): 1-3 with snow and blowing snow becoming unrestricted

Wind (kts): NE 15-25 gusting 35

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -20°C / -4°F

Wind (kts): W 10-15

Max Temp: -6°C / 21°F
