

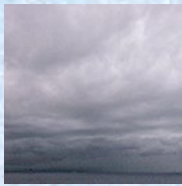

PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

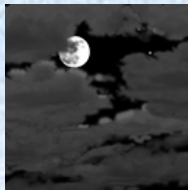

Today the station will be in between two transient low pressure centers and as a result will see the cloud cover and lingering sporadic snow showers move out of the area later this evening. Overnight will be mild with partly cloudy skies and fairly light winds. By early morning Saturday expect another round of significant snow with winds starting to pick up from the NW and last all day.
