

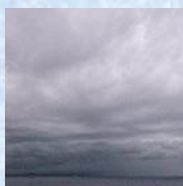

**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

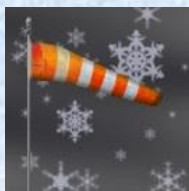
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Anvers Island is in the midst of several disorganized low pressure systems passing over the Antarctic Peninsula causing continued cloud cover through the period. The station will see the most significant impacts tonight as visibility will drop with snow showers and blowing snow. Tomorrow will see less snow and wind but prevalent sky cover.

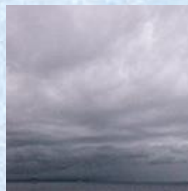

**Sky:** Mostly Cloudy becoming Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted with occasional 3-5 with light snow in late afternoon

**Wind (kts):** NW 5-10

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 1-3 with snow and blowing snow with occasional ½ with snow and blowing snow
