

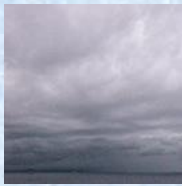

PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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Anvers Island is still under the influence of a large disorganized low pressure system. Consequently continued low clouds and intermittent light snow will continue throughout the day along with westerly winds. Tomorrow the low moves across the Antarctic Peninsula leaving high pressure which will provide a clearing of the clouds and a really nice day on the station.
