PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

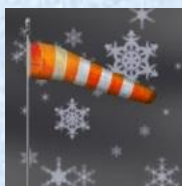
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An intense low pressure system with impressive comma cloud signature, as evident on satellite imagery, strengthens and moves into the Bellingshausen Sea from the west. Indications are for strong winds with periods of heavy precipitation significantly reducing surface visibility. Expect the strongest winds, with gusts of up to 60 knots, late tonight and continuing into early tomorrow, decreasing by late afternoon as the system begins to weaken.
