PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

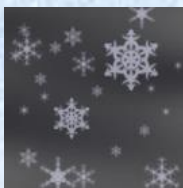

Palmer station remains under the effects of a low-pressure system making its way across the Antarctic Peninsula. Expect increased wind speeds throughout most of the day today, calming down in the evening. Overnight, a few flurries will continue and fog is expected to develop.

snow during the evening

Wind (kts): NE-E 5-10
becoming NE-E 15-20 gusting
30 in the evening
