PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

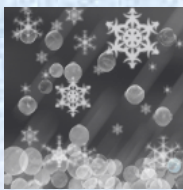

Two rapidly moving low pressure systems are transitioning across the Antarctic Peninsula today and as a result, Anvers Island will continue to see degraded conditions due to snow. By Friday, expect conditions to improve as the precipitation and cloud cover move out of the area but are replaced by stronger winds and consequently, lower wind chill values throughout the day.
