## REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Big storm out there! It's well northwest of station and is slowly drifting to the east. Batten down the hatches today as peak gusts could be around 60kts. The winds will drastically decrease after dinner and becoming generally light. The will pick back up late tomorrow evening, but won't be quite as strong as today. A lot of precipitation today, depending on the temperature, rain during the warmer periods and a mix when it cools.
