## PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

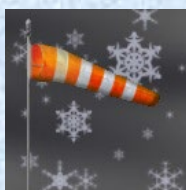
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Another exciting day of unsettled weather. A cool morning with occasional flurries ending and the sun trying to make its presence known, only to be beaten back by the next weather maker, a low moving into the Bellingshausen Sea. Pack up the patio furniture and umbrella's as gusts could be as high as 50kts! Winds will start late tonight lasting into tomorrow, though slowly decreasing through the day. A mixed bag of precipitation can be expected and temperatures tomorrow will warm.

**Sky:** Mostly Cloudy becoming Partly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasional flurries ending early

**Wind (kts):** Light & Variable, becoming NE 15-20 gusts to 30 late evening

**Max Temp:** -1°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 2-4, occasional <1 w/rain/snow/mix, blowing snow

**Wind (kts):** NE 30-40 gusts to 50

**Min Temp:** -1°C / 27°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -11°C / 12°F

**Sky** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 3-5, occasional <1 w/rain/snow/mix

**Wind (kts):** NE 30-40 gusts to 50, decreasing through the day to 15-20 gusts to 30

**Max Temp:** 2°C / 36°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -9°C / 16°F
