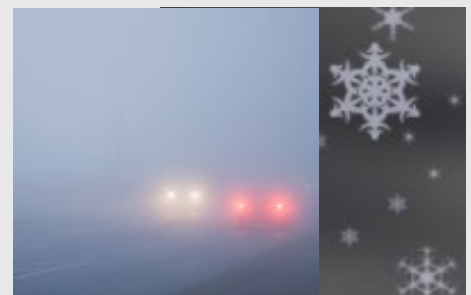
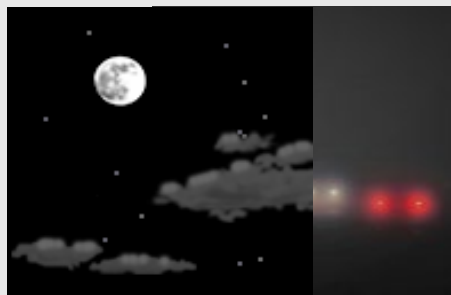
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure in the Weddell Sea is still the main player in the weather for most of this period. However, it will exit the area tomorrow with an approaching trough moving in from the west. A nice day today before some fog forms late tonight, clearing tomorrow morning. The trough enters changing conditions bringing some light snow tomorrow night.
