A relatively weak front is currently dissolving along the Antarctic Peninsula. As it does so, Palmer may experience elevated winds in the morning and occasional showers throughout the day. As the low pressure system weakens, winds should decline to light and variable, and weather should be mostly favorable for the rest of the forecast period.






