



A 951mb Low sits just to the northwest of Anvers Island, with troughing stretching out well to the west from this main Low. This system will affect your weather through 25/18Z timeframe, when a ridge of High pressure builds southward over your track briefly with improving conditions. Low pressure once again moves in over your track by 26/04Z, bringing another dose of precipitation. Cloudy skies prevail with periods of reduced visibility in snow/rain mix and fog, with winds predominantly from the WNW in the 15-30 knot range. Seas will be from the WNW in the 10-14 foot range throughout.

**FORECASTER NOTES** Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
