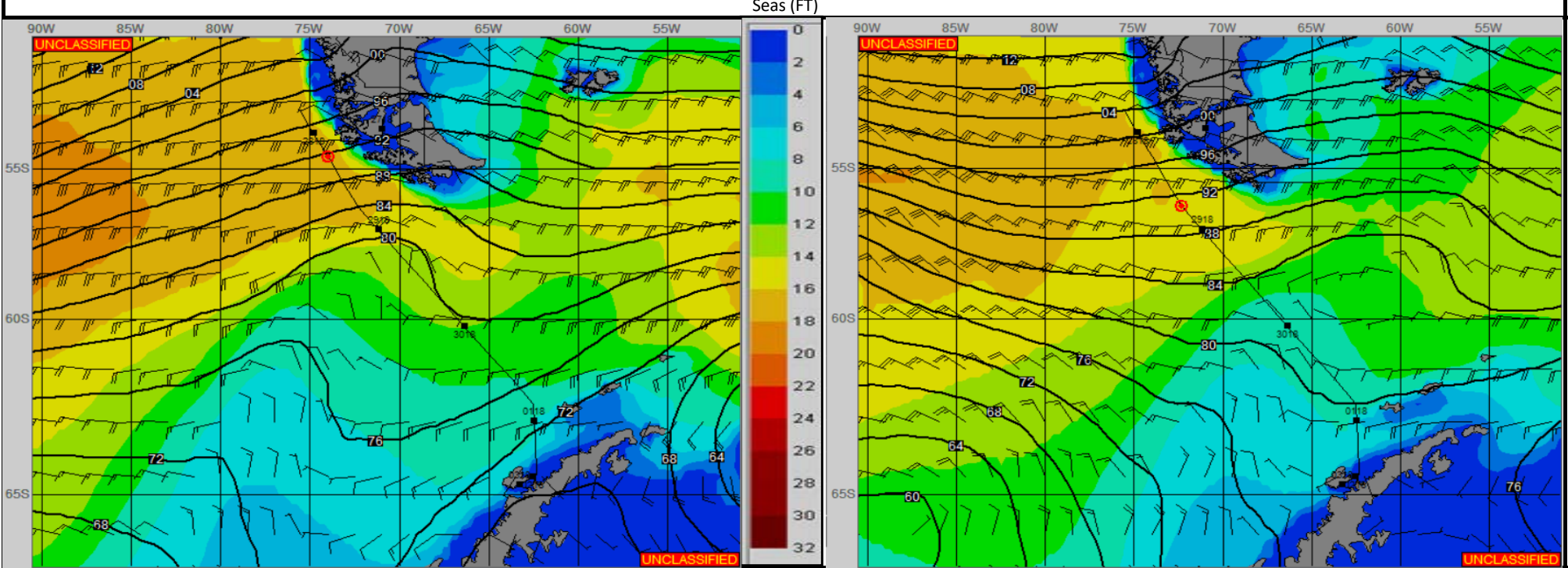


**SURFACE ANALYSIS 29-Nov-2020 00Z**

**METSIT 00Z 29-Nov** The long fetch of relatively strong west to northwest winds will continue through Monday morning, then begin to abate somewhat Monday afternoon. A chilly rain, with occasional visibility of a mile or less, will continue into this evening. However, generally fair weather is expected by later tonight, although cloudy conditions will persist. You may encounter some fog Monday morning. Temperatures will gradually cool on Monday but remain above freezing.
