



METSIT 06Z 30-Nov A large, strong low pressure center will move east across the Antarctic Peninsula today and tomorrow. A long fetch of moderate to strong west winds will continue to send high seas through the Drake Passage. However, wind speeds and sea heights will begin to subside tonight as you move closer to the broad center of the low. Fair weather is expected through this forecast period, though periods of mist will reduce visibility below 3 miles at times.
