

## **FORECASTER NOTES**

Forecast based on operations to the east and south of Anvers Island and protected waters of the southern Gerlache Strait; Open waters West and North of Anvers Island will exceed 15 feet with extended periods of storm force winds. Weather conditions will vary significantly based upon location, and available shelter and/or exposure. Winds/seas may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
