

METSIT 00Z 11-May Winds and mixed precipitation will end early today, offering a brief respite before the next low pushes in late Tuesday night. Strong northerly winds with occasionally heavy mixed precipitation will dominate Wednesday's weather. Open waters West and North of Anvers Island will exceed 18 feet, with swells over 10 feet passing south of the island and extended periods of storm force winds.

FORECASTER NOTES

Forecast based on operations to the east and south of Anvers Island and protected waters of the southern Gerlache Strait; Weather conditions will vary significantly based upon location, and available shelter and/or exposure. Winds/seas may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
