

19-Dec 1029MB HIGH NEAR 48.5S 95W CREATING A BROAD WEST-SOUTHWESTERLY FLOW AGAINST LOW PRESSURE FROM THE AMUNDSEN/BELLINGSHAUSEN SEA THROUGH THE NORTHWEST WEDDELL SEA WITH A 963MB LOW CENTER OVER THURSTON ISLAND AND A 966MB NEAR 65S 057W. A WARM FRONTAL WAVE WILL PUSH INTO THE SHIP TRACK FROM 20/0000Z THROUGH 20/1800Z BRINGING HIGHER WIND GUSTING TO THE MID 40'S, HIGHER SEAS, AND REDUCED VISIBILITY IN RAIN.

FORECASTER NOTES WINDS MAY DIFFER FROM THOSE FORECAST DUE TO FUNNELING / SHELTERING EFFECTS OF ISLANDS.
