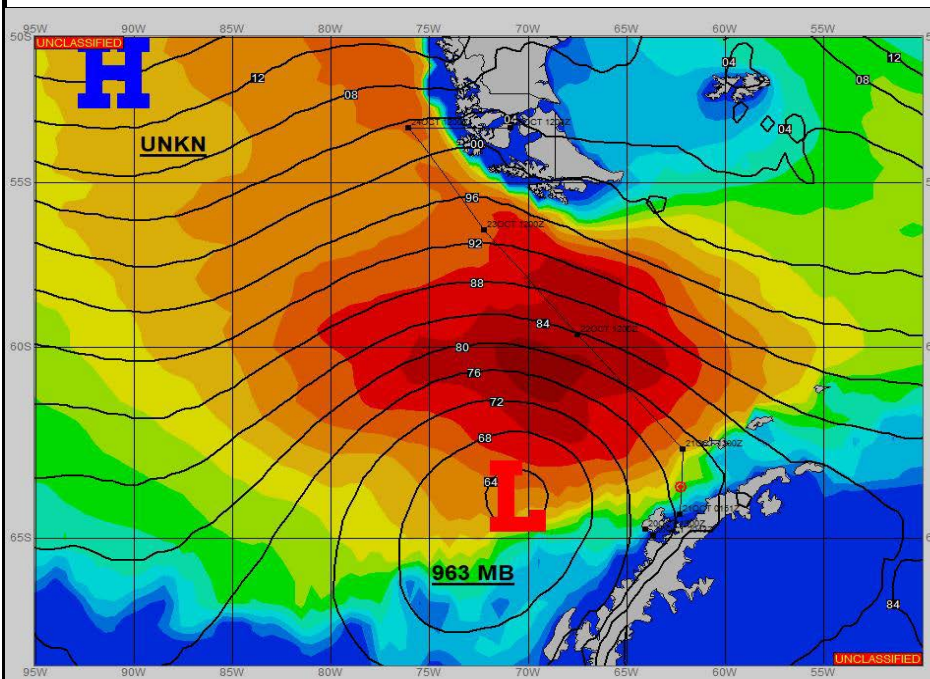

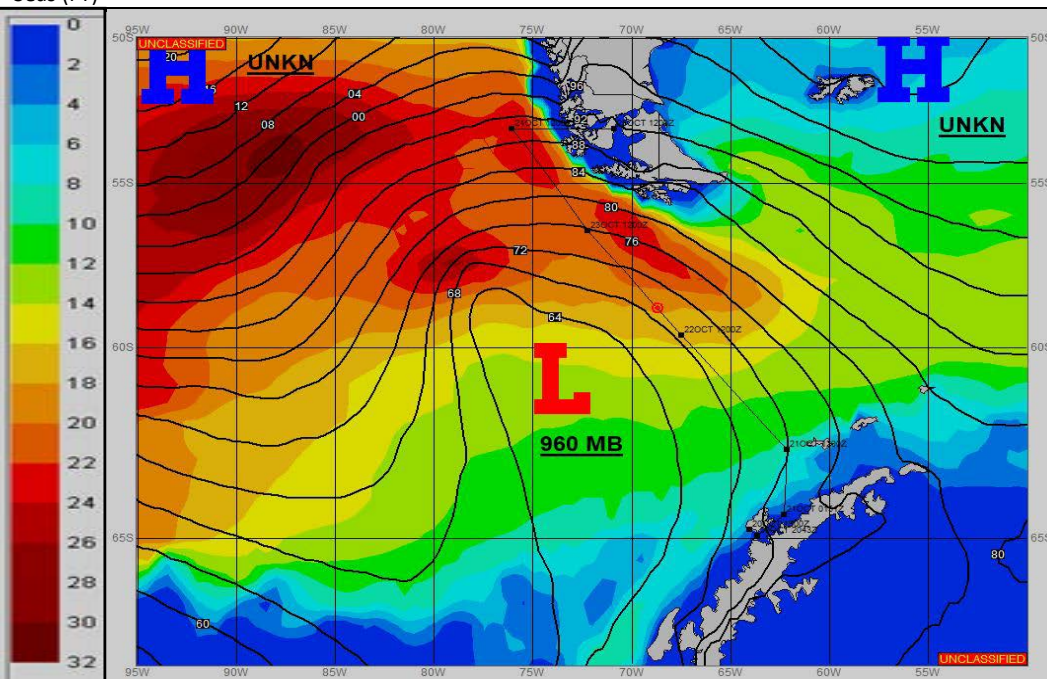

**METSIT 06Z 21-Oct** BROAD, TIGHTLY WOUND 963MB LOW NEAR 64S 071W WILL BRING GUSTY WINDS, REDUCED VISIBILITY IN PRECIPITATION AND FOG, AND HIGHER SEAS AS IT FILLS AND CONTINUES TO TRACK EAST-SOUTHEAST TOWARDS THE NORTHERN ANTARCTIC PENINSULA. THE SHIP TRACK SHOULD SEE IMPROVED VISIBILITY AND SLIGHT EASE IN WINDS FROM 21/1800Z AS A TRANSIENT RIDGE OF HIGH PRESSURE MOVES EAST ACROSS THE DRAKE PASSAGE. A FRONTAL BOUNDARY BEGINS TO AFFECT YOUR ROUTE BY 22/12Z, BRINGING A HEAVIER DOSE OF PRECIPITATION AS WELL AS STRONGER WINDS CONTINUING THROUGH END OF PERIOD.
