

High pressure into the southeast Pacific, in conjunction with low pressure south of the Falkland Islands continues to produce W-SW'erly winds over the Tierra del Fuego region. Seas and winds will diminish toward the end of the forecast period. Winds will become more westerly as you transit the Straits, with stronger winds in exposed waters. Expect mostly cloudy to cloudy skies, with brief, rain/snow showers up to your arrival.

FORECASTER NOTES

Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands. This is my final forecast unless otherwise required. Timely observations received from your ship greatly appreciated.
