

A VERY BROAD 971MB LOW SITUATED NEAR 60S 86W STRETCHING THROUGH THE SOUTHERN DRAKE BEGINS TO STRETCH OUT IN A MORE SOUTHEAST-NORTHWEST FASHION BY 01/00Z, BRINGING STRENGTHENED NORTHWESTERLY WINDS AND A GOOD DEAL OF RAIN OVER YOUR TRACK. THE HEAVIEST PRECIPITATION WILL OCCUR BETWEEN 01/12Z THROUGH 02/00Z AS THE LOW MOVES IN DIRECTLY OVER YOUR TRACK. THE WINDS BECOME SOUTHWESTERLY AND INTENSIFY AFTER 02/00Z AS WELL, INCREASING INTO THE 25-50 KNOT RANGE.
