

A 961MB LOW SITUATED NEAR 59S 164E CONTINUES TO MOVE TO THE EAST-SOUTHEAST, WITH A FRONTAL BOUNDARY SWEEPING IN OVER YOUR TRACK EARLY IN PERIOD, KEEPING REDUCED VISIBILITIES IN SNOW THROUGH 01/15Z. WINDS SHIFT FROM THE NORTHEAST EARLY PERIOD TO A GRADUAL EAST-SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION BY 01/00Z WHILE INCREASING IN SPEEDS. BY 01/03Z, THE LOW WILL BE DIRECTLY NORTH OF YOUR LOCATION, WITH A CENTRAL PRESSURE OF 968MB. THE LOW CONTINUES TO PUSH TO THE EAST-SOUTHEAST, CAUSING THE WINDS TO SHIFT TO THE SOUTH BY 01/18Z AND BEGIN TO ABATE SLOWLY AS YOU GET ON THE BACKSIDE OF THE LOW, WITH THE VISIBILITY IMPROVING NICELY AS THE SNOW ENDS. SEAS GRADUALLY DECREASE THROUGHOUT THE PERIOD, WITH A PORTION IN THE LATTER HALF (01/21Z - 02/03Z) GOING NIL.
