



METSIT 00Z 1-Apr The final stretch to the shelter of Anvers Island should see you there safely ahead of the looming area of big waves, then that area at last weakens in intensity over the second day of this forecast period. Expect lingering snow showers, fog and occasionally gusty winds (largely local terrain dependent) in the vicinity of the island in the wake of the system as it departs.

FORECASTER NOTES 24 and 48 hour position plots from 31 Mar SITREP have your location on the lee side of Anvers Island without making port. Forecast here is presented accordingly. Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
