

METSIT 06Z TIGHT PRESSURE GRADIENT ACROSS DRAKE'S PASSAGE WILL DIMINISH THROUGH THE FORECAST PERIOD AS HIGH PRESSURE RECEDES INTO THE SOUTH ATLANTIC, AND THE LOW PRESSURE 1-Dec STRADDLING THE ANTARCTIC PENINSULA CONTINUES TO WEAKEN. EXPECT GENERALLY GOOD SKY CONDITIONS VISIBILITY WITH A CHANCE OF FOG LATE IN THE FORECAST PERIOD.
