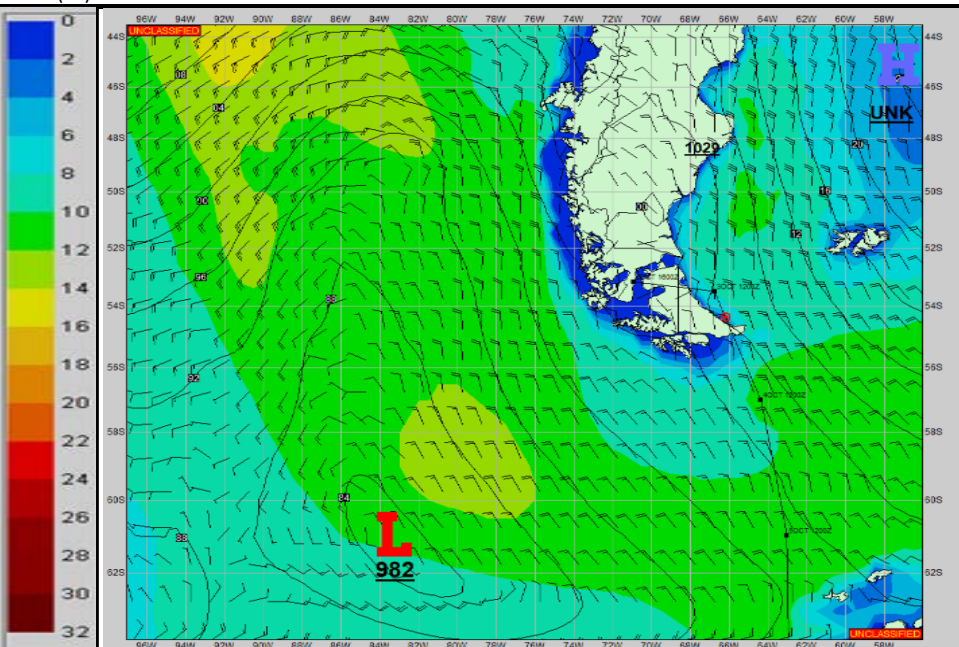
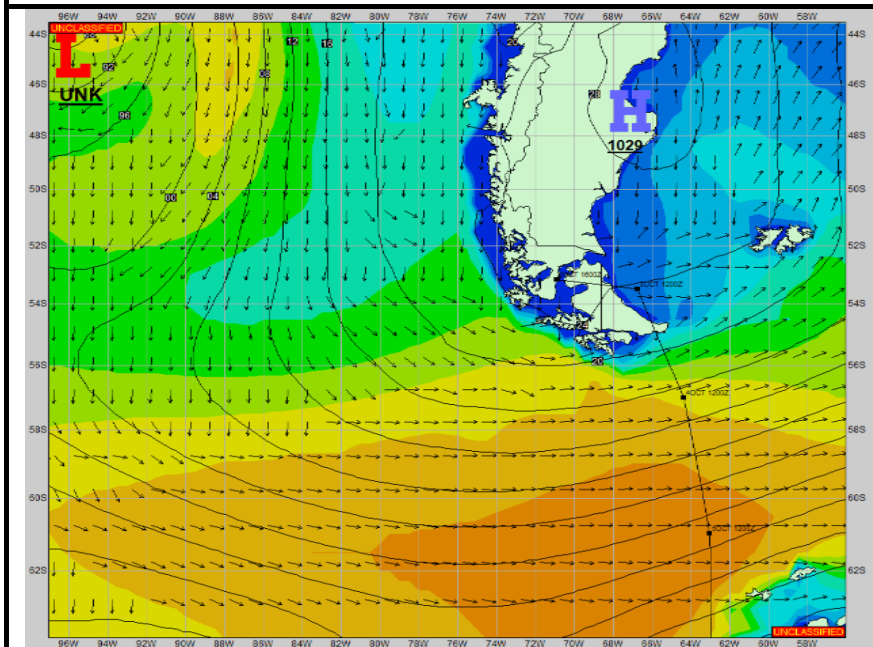

METSIT 06Z 2-Oct High pressure over Argentina will provide fair weather for your departure and Strait transit. The interaction of this high, and low pressure centered west of Chile will produce moderate Northerly winds and seas as you exit the Strait and begin your southbound turn. This pattern will prevail over the next several days as you enter the Drake passage.

FORECASTER NOTES Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands. To assist with ship tracking and ensure the most accurate forecast possible, please include updated waypoints out to 48hrs with all SITREPs.
