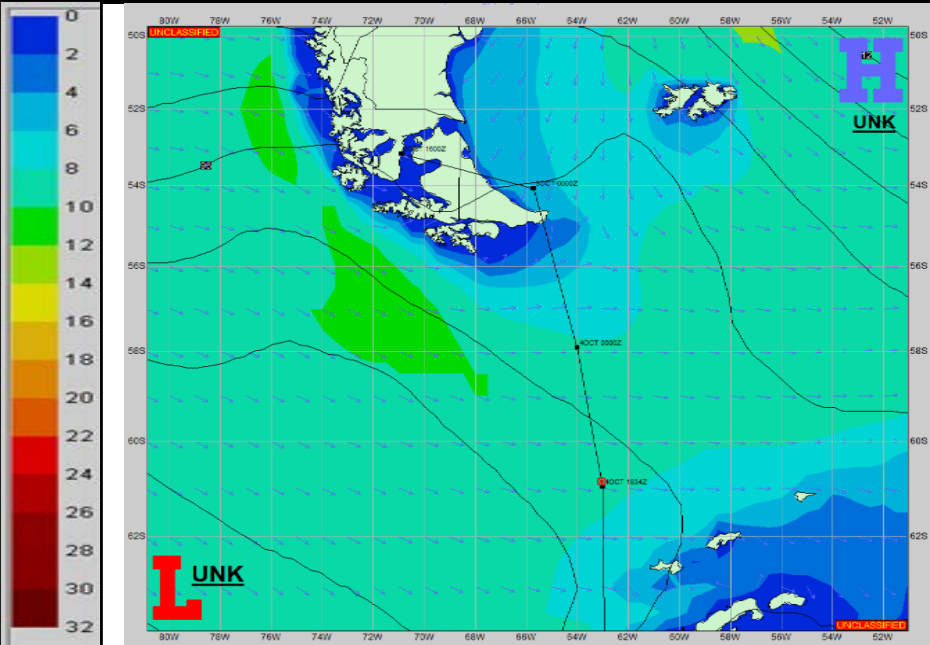
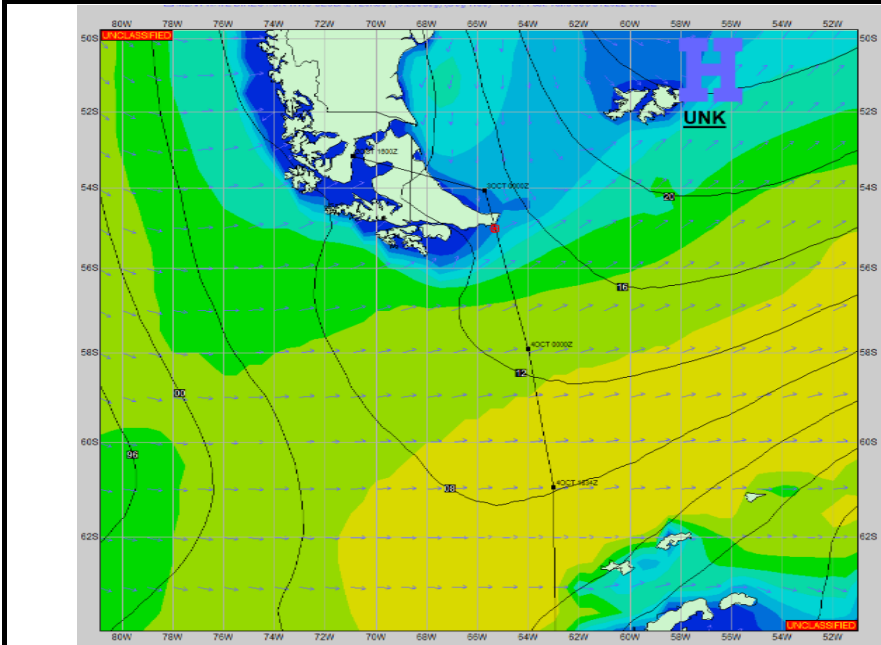

METSIT 06Z 3-Oct A low pressure system is entering the Bellinghousen Sea as high pressure slowly moves east of the Falkland Islands. Your route will keep you east of the front today with northerly winds backing north-west as you begin the Drake Passage Transit. Skies will be cloudy with areas of fog developing. Periods of snow mixed with sleet will develop late in the forecast period and throughout the outlook period as the low moves further into the Southern Bellinghousen Sea. Expect predominant waves to be mostly 8-11 foot swells to the east in the Drake Passage. (Combined sig wave heights provided below)

FORECASTER NOTES Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands. To assist with ship tracking and ensure the most accurate forecast possible, please include updated waypoints out to 48hrs with all SITREPs.
