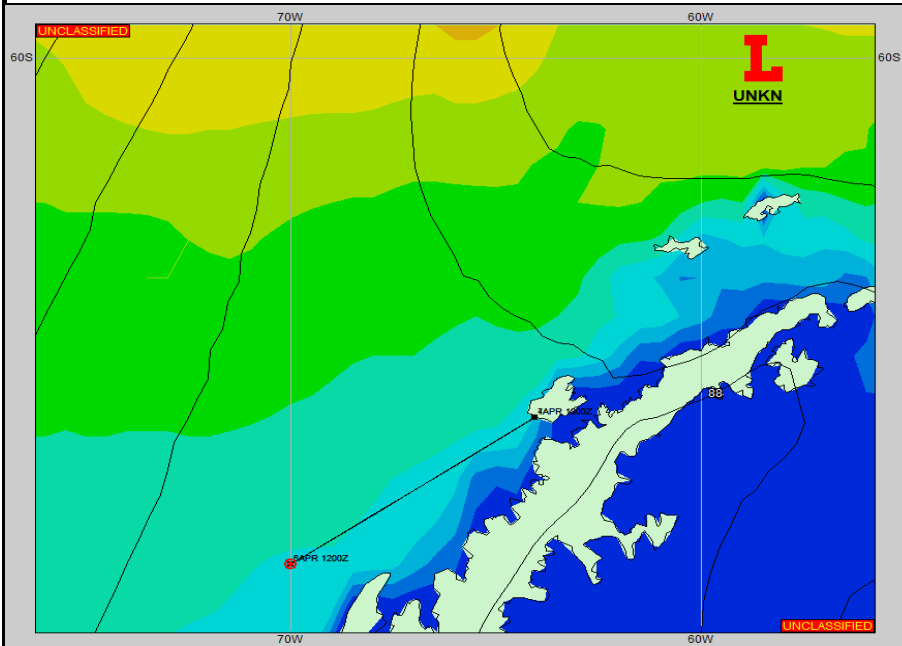


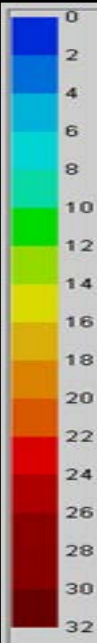

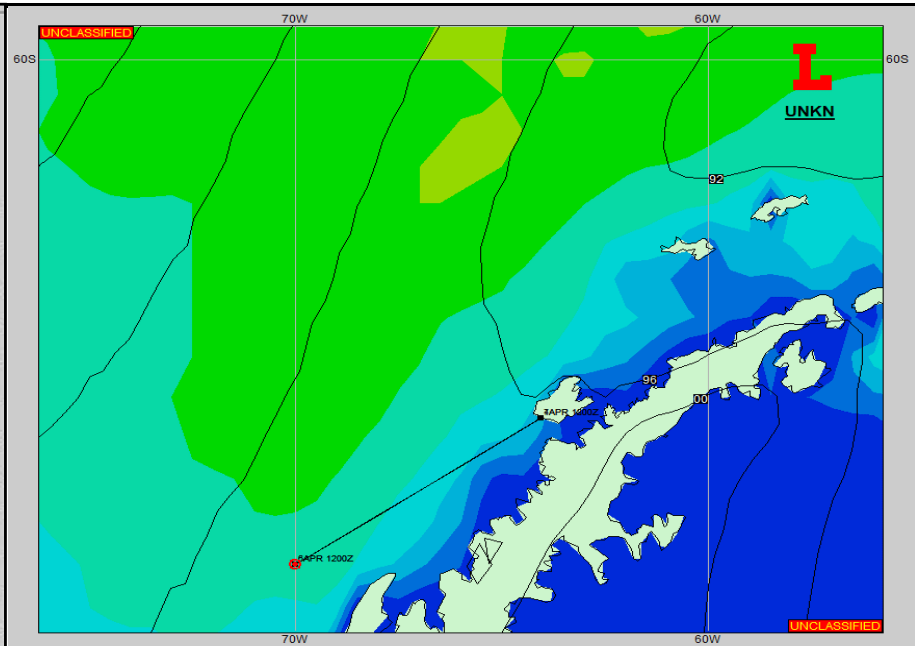
SURFACE FORECAST 5-Apr-2022 12Z

METSIT 18Z 4-Apr As the low pressure center exits eastward through the Drake expect generally fair conditions. Patchy fog likely, particularly in the morning hours. Light winds today, increasing a bit tomorrow when the pressure gradient begins to increase slightly as a ridge builds in from the northwest.
