

METSIT 18Z 4-Mar WINDS AND SEAS WILL BEGIN TO SUBSIDE AS YOU MOVE FARTHER AWAY FROM THE LARGE LOW CENTERED NEAR THE SOUTHERN TIP OF SOUTH AMERICA, AND THIS LOW SLOWLY WEAKENS. VISIBILITY WILL OCCASIONALLY BE REDUCED BELOW 3NM IN MIST.
