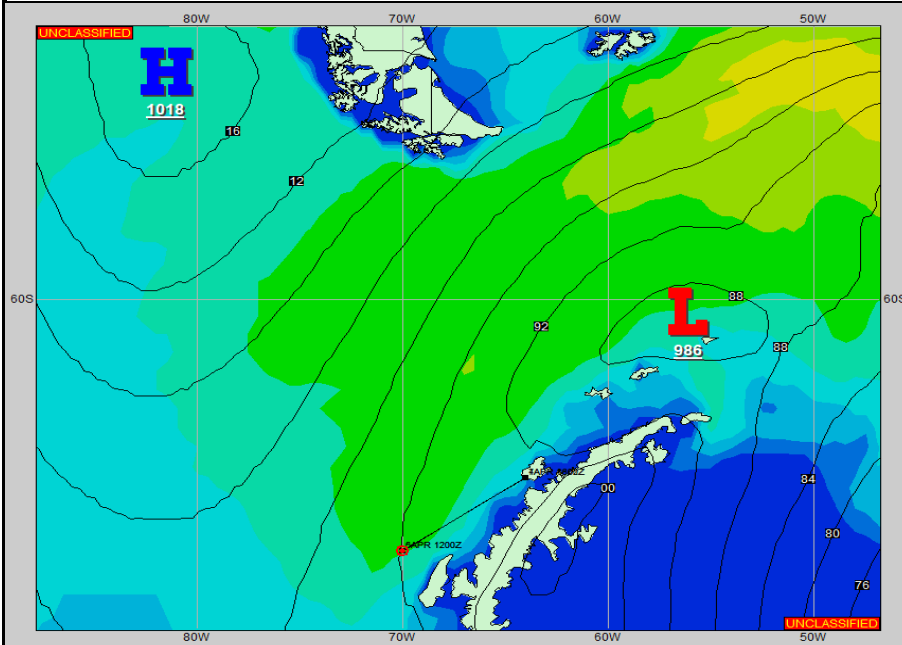


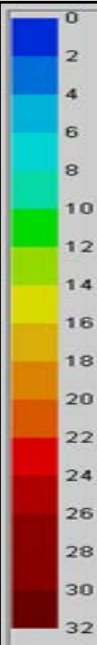

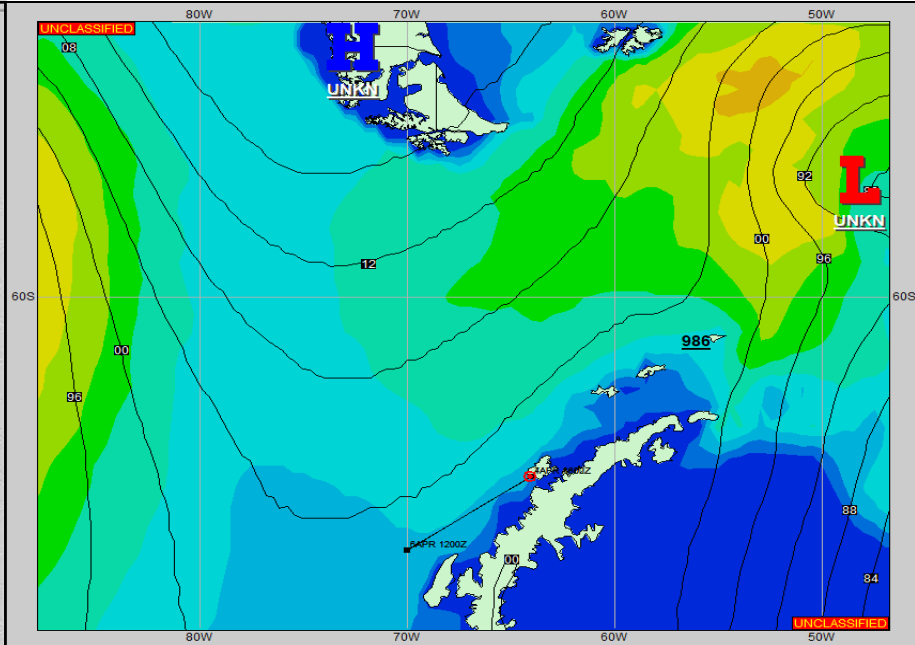
**SURFACE FORECAST 6-Apr-2022 12Z**

A weak trough extends from the low in the Drake southwestward. That feature interacts with the approaching high pressure to establish a strong pressure gradient, in turn producing gusty winds in your operating area. That shouldn't persist beyond today, as the eastward push of the high helps eject the low northeastward through this period.

Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
