



METSIT 00Z 6-May Rough weather so far - but unfortunately the worst appears to be still ahead. The low center currently throwing winds and waves in your path will weaken and pass through the peninsula, providing a brief respite from the more violent weather. But an even more powerful low tracks from the South Pacific towards the South American coast tomorrow. Expect gusts exceeding 50 knots aft 07/03Z, then storm-force sustained winds by 12Z; ultimately gusts near 70 knots tomorrow afternoon. Seas will likewise exceed 20-25 feet through the afternoon tomorrow.

FORECASTER NOTES Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
