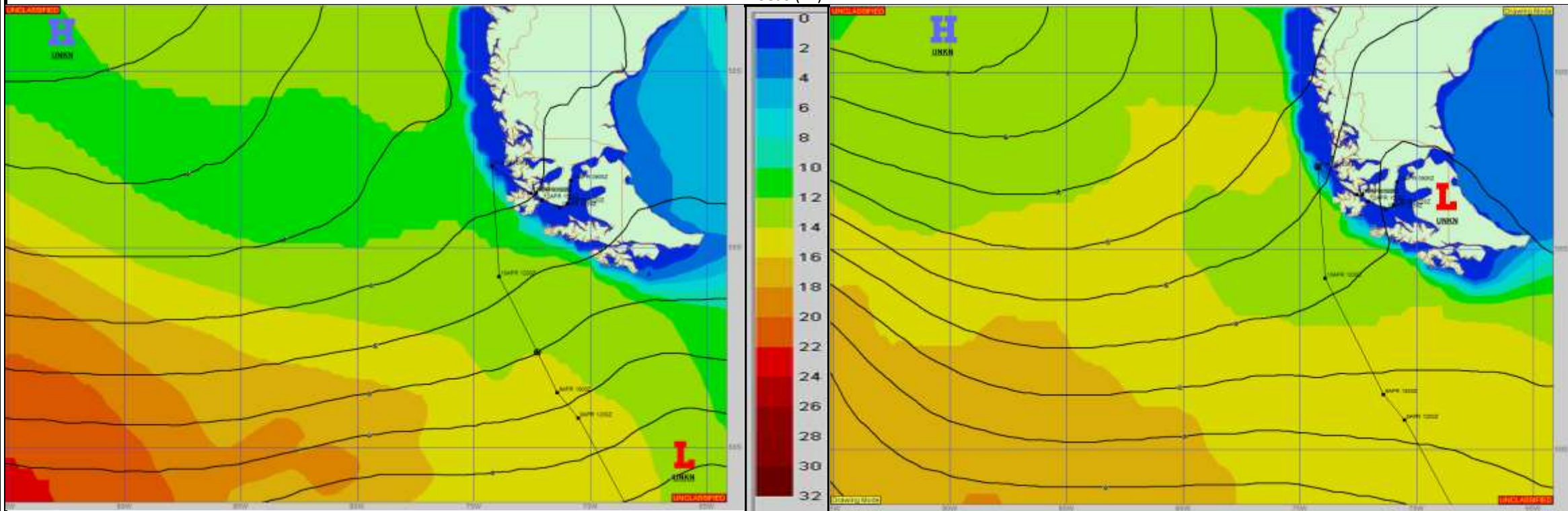


SURFACE ANALYSIS 10-Apr-2022 00Z

METSIT 00Z 10-Apr The frontal boundary moves east of your track early in the forecast period and will be replaced by a broad, "flat" high pressure ridge. Sky condition and precipitation are expected to improve and be favorable for at least the first half of the forecast, but a strong westerly will still be a factor. Winds will decrease as you exit the Drake and another low pressure center moves over the route, which will cause a return of increased cloudiness and rain.

FORECASTER NOTES Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
