



**METSIT 18Z 10-Apr** Waves of low pressure continue to churn things up along the route - but you'll have made the inland waterways before the deeper low starts rocking the Drake tomorrow. During the early morning hours your route passes through one of the projected locations of a low center (eastward-moving feature to the west in the upper left image), hence the variable winds (and deteriorating visibility in rain and fog) in the 6Z time frame. Expect windy but dry conditions overnight tomorrow night, until another weak wave brings rain to the vicinity on the 12th.

**FORECASTER NOTES** Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
