



METSIT 18Z 11-Apr The next major low moving into the Drake Passage at this time will help maintain a strong pressure gradient throughout the area, equating to gusty winds outside of areas sheltered by land. Occasional bouts of rain are also likely, though most precipitation will be wrung out along the western South American shore, thus less so tomorrow.
