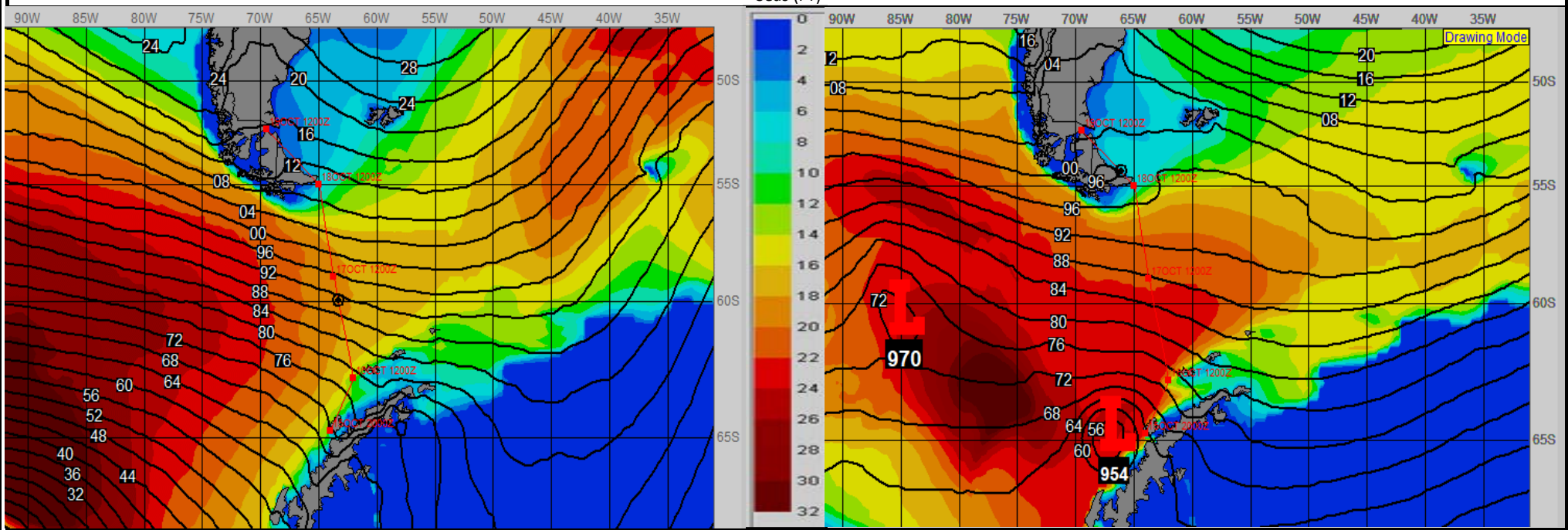


**SURFACE ANALYSIS 17-Oct-2022 06Z**

**METSIT 06Z 17-Oct** The sharp difference between high pressure to the north and very low pressure to the south will cause brisk west to northwest winds to continue across the Drake Passage through the remainder of your voyage. Seas will remain elevated until the vessel reaches the protection of Argentina on Tuesday. Periods of mostly light rain and drizzle will persist into Monday night. The stronger winds will likely prevent dense sea fog.
