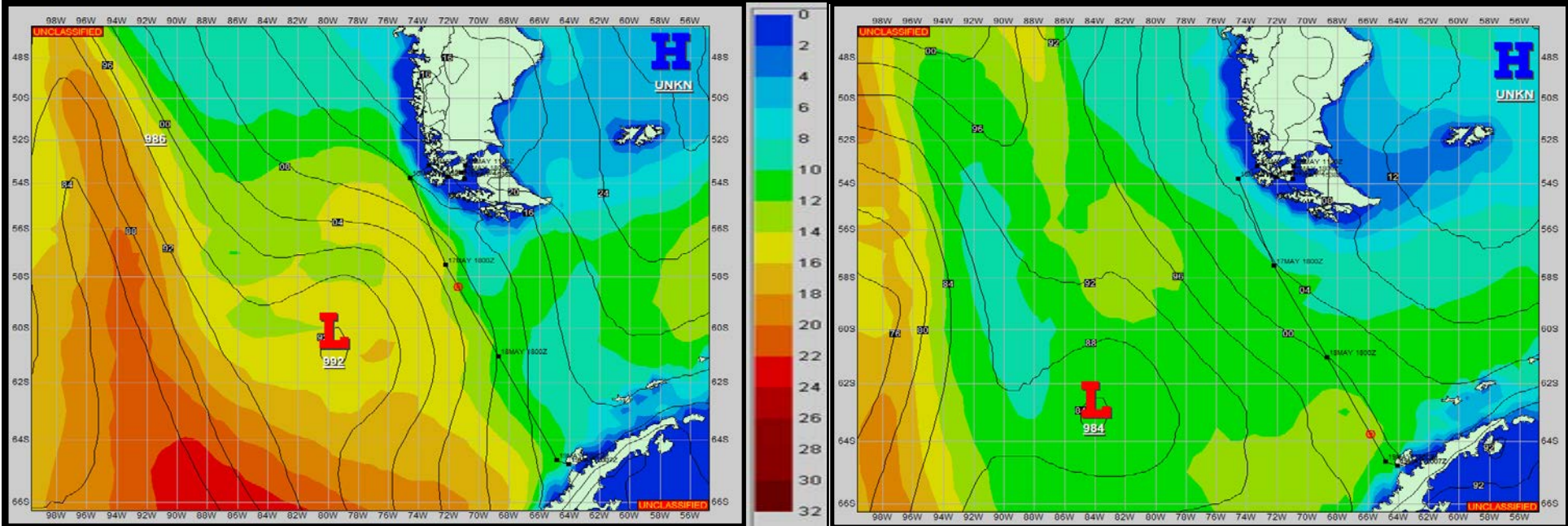


**SURFACE ANALYSIS 18-May-2022 00Z**

**METSIT 00Z 18-May** As seen above, much of this part of the trip south will be spent between high and low pressure centers, which means things will be a bit on the windy side due to that pressure gradient, but not too extreme due to the distance from the actual low. The roughest weather should be behind you by day's end today, but cold and snowy conditions are ahead tomorrow.

**FORECASTER NOTES** Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
