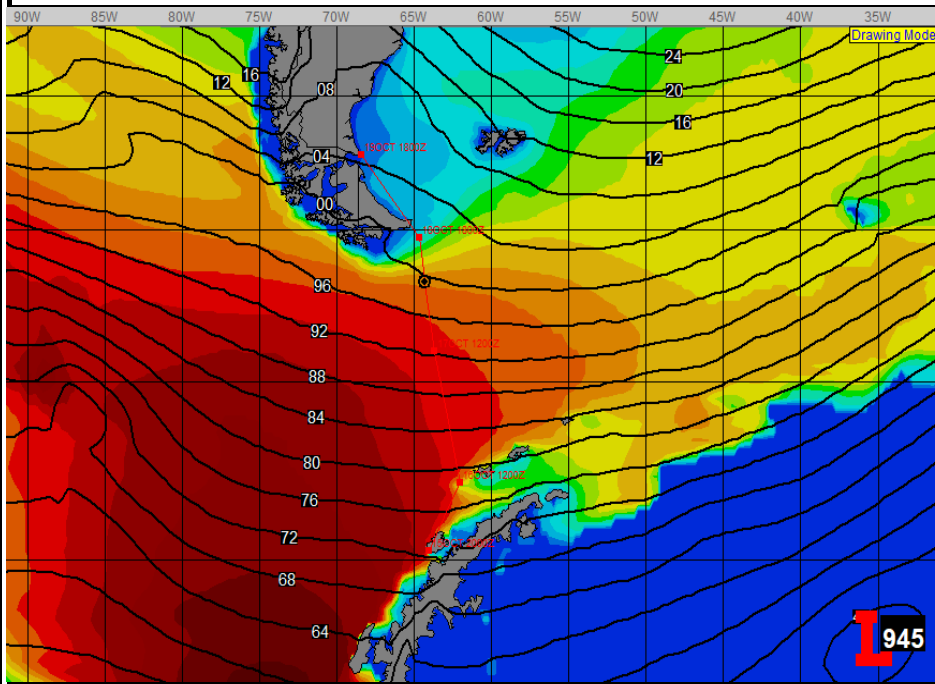
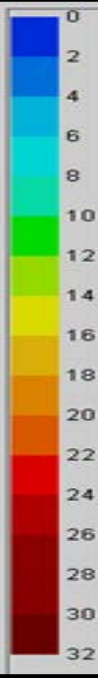


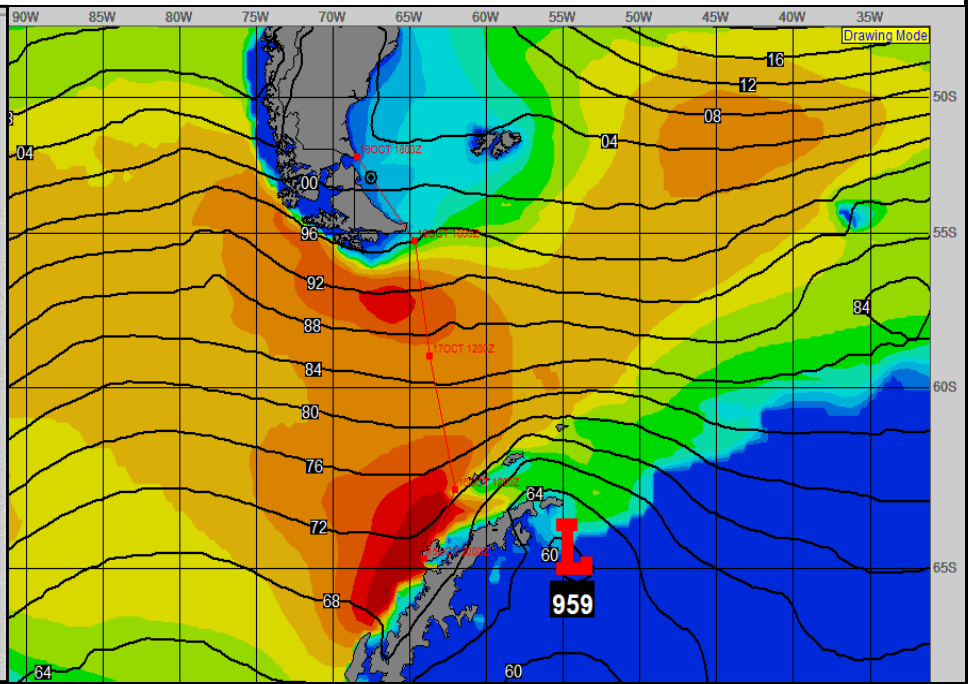

However, brisk W-NW winds will continue through the remainder of the voyage. The LMG will be entering the leeward waters of Argentina today, with seas steadily subsiding along the way.
