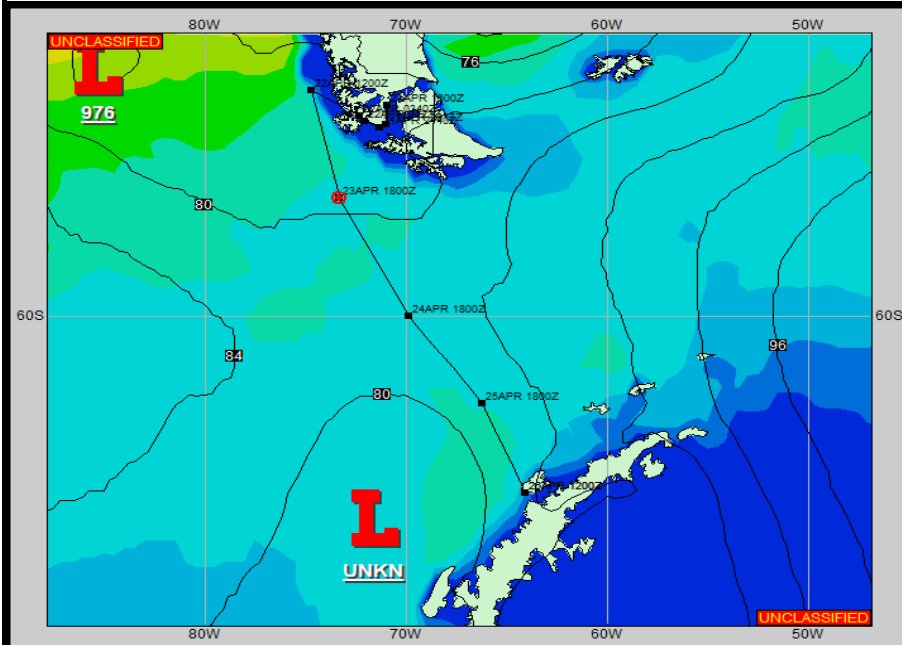
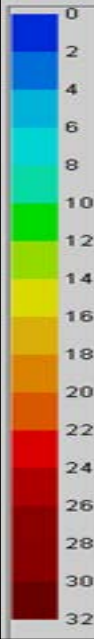


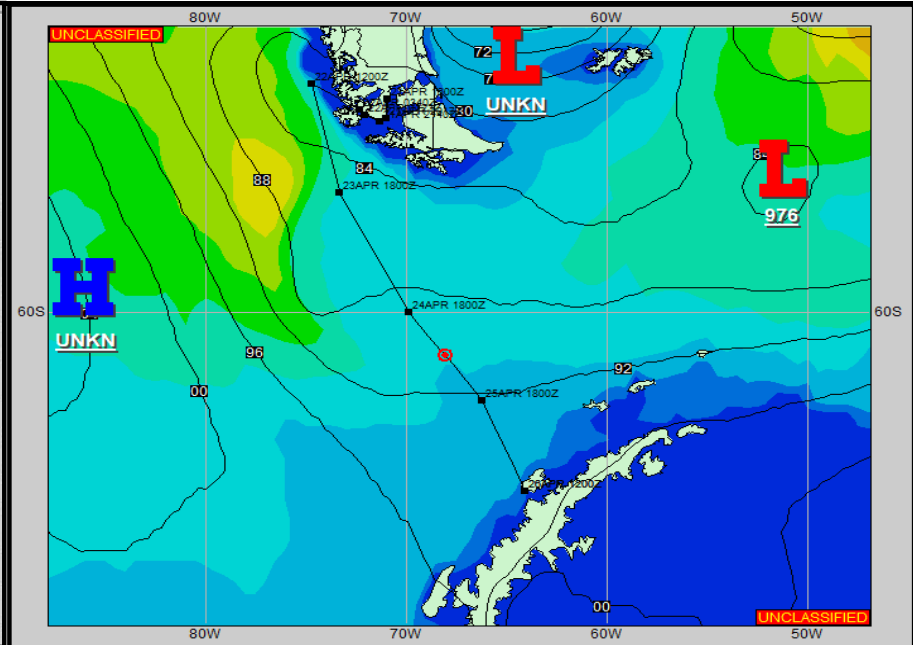
SURFACE ANALYSIS 23-Apr-2022 18Z

METSIT 18Z 23-Apr This period begins with a low pressure center trailing you southward, but by tonight that will begin a retrograde movement back to the north. Still, your route is along a mostly stationary, elongated low pressure trough. The lack of an associated strong pressure gradient means winds (and waves) are generally weak for the Drake, but rain/mixed precip/snow and fog can be expected to continue as you make your way towards Palmer.

FORECASTER NOTES Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
