Little change from previous outlook. You'll never be too far away from snow showers through this period, but increasing patches of blue are likely, too. A persistent, strong pressure gradient through the Drake means anything but smooth sailing, but as previously expected you'll miss the worst of it for winds and waves. Both should have a southerly component for at least this early segment of the crossing.

FORECASTER NOTES Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
