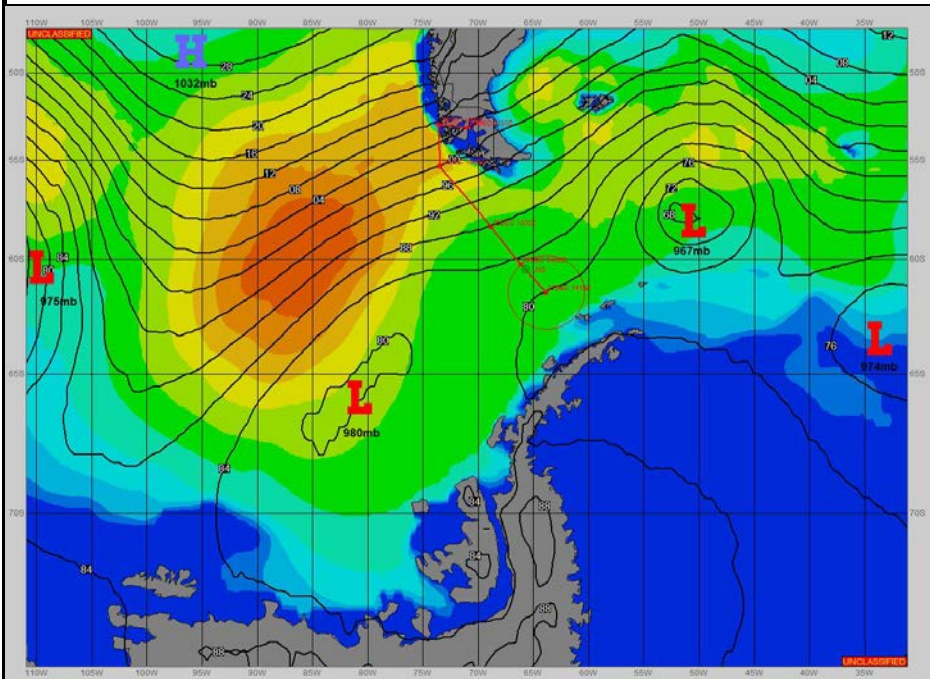
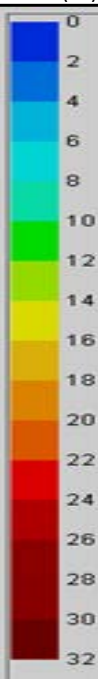


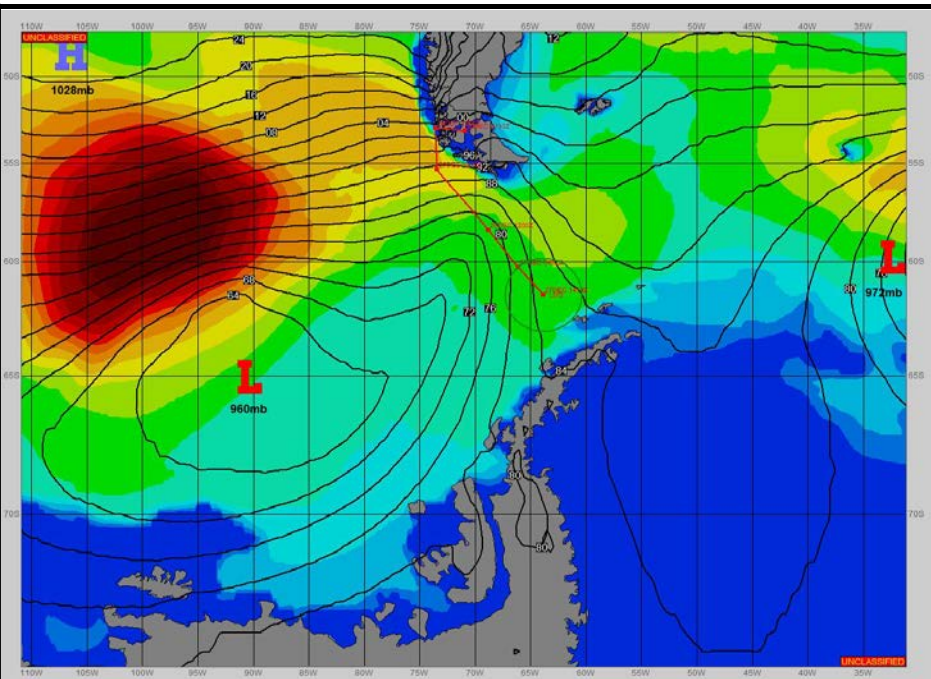

METSIT 06Z 27-Dec A RIDGE OF HIGH PRESSURE IS TEMPORARILY OVERHEAD, SUSTAINING A MODERATE WIND WITH OVERALL CLOUDY AND FOGGY CONDITIONS. HOWEVER, AS THE RIDGE MOVE ON TOMORROW, A LARGE LOW PRESSURE CENTER WILL TAKE ITS PLACE AND APPROACH THE ANTARCTIC PENINSULA. THE WINDS WILL SHIFT TO THE NORTH AND PICK UP SPEED QUITE NOTICEABLY, MAINTAINING THE WAVY STATE OF THE SEA SURFACE. THE WORST OF THE WINDS AND WAVES WILL BE FURTHER NORTH IN THE MORE-OPEN OCEAN, WHILE FURTHER SOUTH WILL PROVIDE SOME DEGREE OF IMPROVEMENT.
