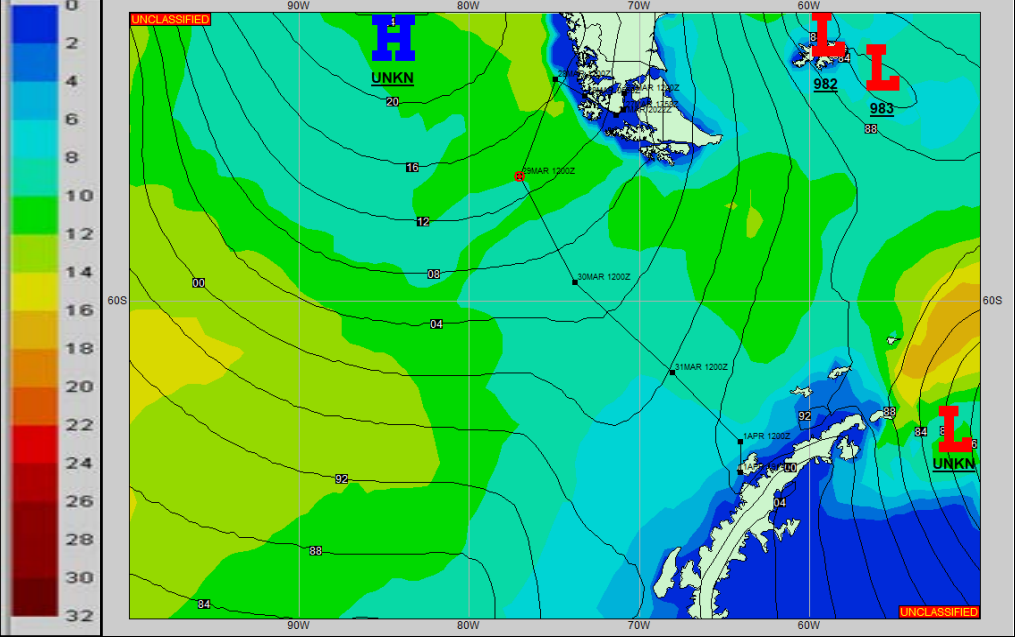
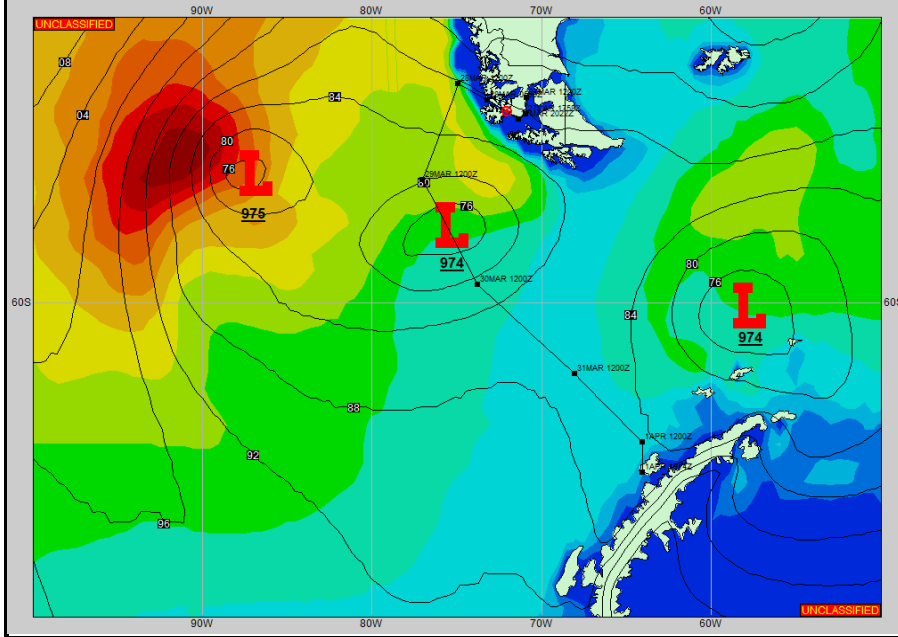


SURFACE ANALYSIS 28-Mar-2022 00Z

METSIT 00Z 28-Mar Consistent with previous forecasts: expect multiple low pressure centers to stir things up just a bit on entrance to the Pacific, but the worst of it should remain well to your north. High pressure moving in should bring slightly smoother sailing by the 29th. Areas of rain should likewise dwindle in coverage, with patchy lingering fog on the morning of the 29th that should be displaced by stronger westerly breezes through the day.

FORECASTER NOTES Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
