

29-Mar Initial portion of this forecast period should see generally improving conditions as high pressure becomes dominant in the area. A lingering strong pressure gradient will keep winds gusty, however. By late tomorrow the deep low moving in from the west (see upper right image) will be making its presence felt in the form of increasing winds, waves, and precipitation. At this time your course keeps you ahead of the worst of it.

**FORECASTER NOTES** Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
