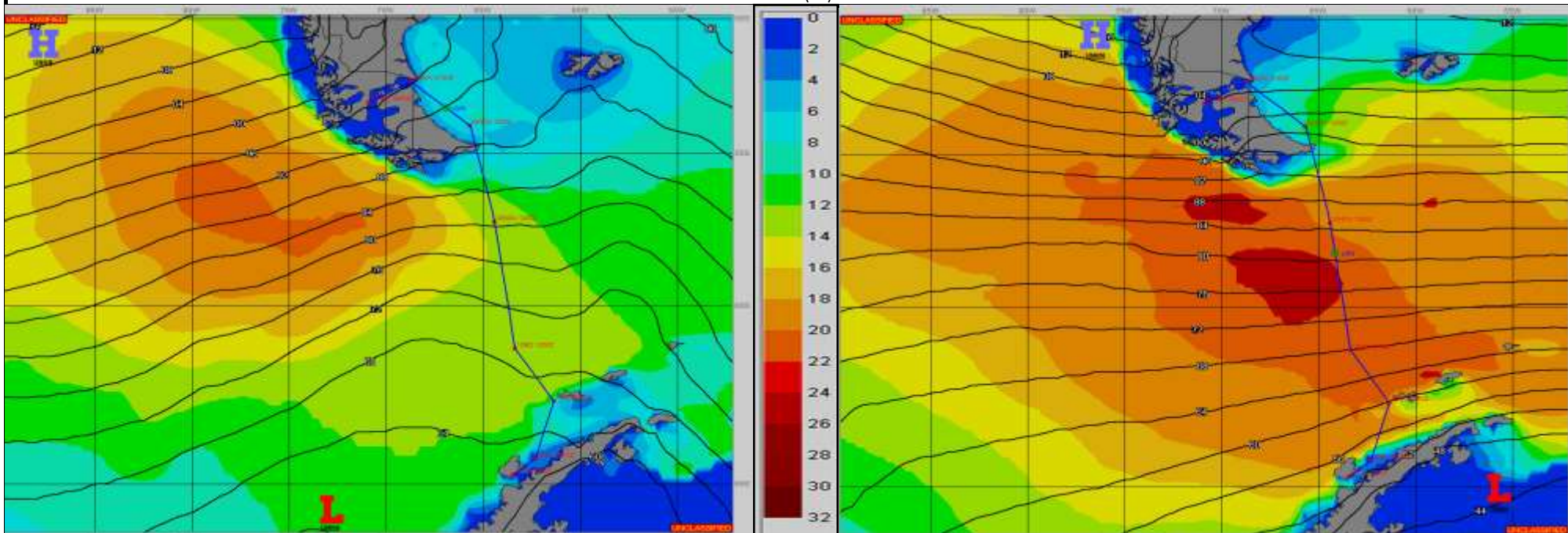


SURFACE ANALYSIS 29-Nov-2022 06Z

METSIT 06Z 29-Nov SATELLITE IMAGERY SHOWS THE FRONTAL BOUNDARY HAS PASSED JUST EAST OF YOUR POSITION AT THE TIME OF THIS ANALYSIS. SATELLITE AND MODEL DATA SUGGEST THAT WHILE SKIES AND VISIBILITY WILL BE MUCH IMPROVED BEHIND THE FRONT, STRONG WEST/NORTHWESTERLY WINDS WILL CONTINUE FOR THE ENTIRETY OF THE FORECAST PERIOD. THE NEXT ROUND OF PRECIPITATION AND HEAVY CLOUDINESS IS EXPECTED TOMORROW MORNING AS YOU ENTER THE DRAKE, AND THE LONG FETCH OF STRONG WINDS WILL ALSO MEAN CONTENDING WITH HIGH SEA STATES.
