

Struct generally fair weather to end the year, but a low pressure center making its way into the Drake from the southwest will bring a brief period of snow and slightly gusty winds on New Year's Day. That low should remain far enough to the north of your location as it passes to keep peak winds below 30 knots and seas below 10 feet.
